Southeastern Federal Credit Union Breaks Ground

VALDOSTA, Georgia, February 15, 2008 – Southeastern Federal Credit Union announced today that it has broken ground for its new headquarters and branch office in Valdosta. With \$100 million in assets, the Credit Union has achieved significant growth since its inception in 1953, and is currently the largest Credit Union in South Georgia with branch locations in Valdosta, Tifton and Moody AFB.

The new headquarters facility will span a total of 25,000 square feet and will be located on a prominent 2.8 acre corner lot in Valdosta. The building's new façade is designed to make a statement to the community and exemplify what the Credit Union represents: strength, stability, and high quality member service. The retail lobby will welcome members with a meeter/greeter station and business center, giving them an area to take care of personal business, such as faxing, printing and scanning during their visit to the branch. The lobby will also include plasma screens, banners and posters that will promote the Credit Union's products and services. Three drive-thru lanes and a drive-up ATM will be available to give members added convenience. In addition, a large board room will be located on the second floor that can be transformed into a training room. An open patio for hosting employee and community functions will be located adjacent to the boardroom over the drive-up.

“This structure will be the face of Southeastern the next fifteen plus years. We want to make sure the look and stature represents not only the appropriate image of the Credit Union, but the region in which we do business as well. And, with the tremendous growth we've had, this facility will allow us to provide the level of service our members have come to expect,” said Lee Morgan, President/CEO, Southeastern Federal Credit Union.
